#### **BUZZ** and GenuisSiS:

• We use BUZZ (Learning Management System - think of it as the classroom) and GenuisSIS (Student Information System - think of it as the school office).

### What to Expect as a Homeschool Teacher?

- 1. Learning guides/parents have full control of the final deadlines for assignments. While PCPA's parent-led homeschooling program courses calculate suggested due dates for students to stay on pace, this is just a recommendation and you have the ability to change dates.
- 2. Our LMS provides a great grading tool for learning guides to use and keep track of their student's grades, so utilize it to help you and your student stay organized.
- 3. Genius will provide the transcript for you after you complete all the grading and record them on Buzz. Please note that the transcript will not appear until the courses have been completed.
- 4. Learning guides have full flexibility on what course content they would like to present to their student. Learning guides can skip, add, delay, or extend any course assignments they would like. Our parent-led homeschooling program provides freedom for learning guides to create a unique and successful learning experience for their student(s).

### Homeschool Tips for Success

- 1. Create a designated learning space. To avoid confusion, keep your children's study materials organized and designate a specific learning hub—a space where they keep supplies and books.
- 2. **Follow a daily schedule.** Students thrive when they have a basic structure and routine. Consider creating and following a daily schedule. You can always adapt, but a schedule will give you focus and direction each day.
- 3. Map out the school year ahead of time. This will help track progress on your goals and plan out big projects. Breaking up big goals and projects into smaller steps makes them more manageable and you're less likely to let details fall through the cracks.
- 4. **Set learning goals together**. Homeschooling gives your child the opportunity to direct and customize their education. When you have a vision and a plan for where you want to go, you are more likely to achieve those learning outcomes and properly align your day-to-day curriculum.

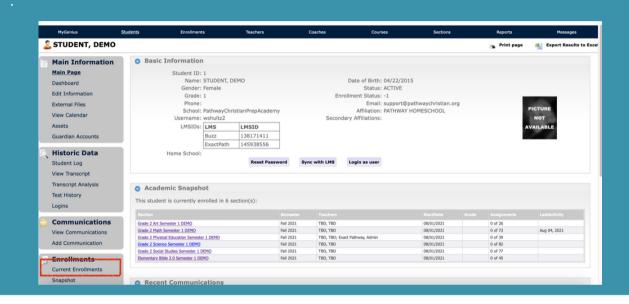


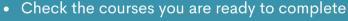
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HOW TO CLOSE OUT THE YEAR AND PRINT MY TRANSCRIP

- Go to your teacher's login.
- Select your student and click "Current Enrollment" on your left said tool bar.
